SUBJECT: GATE SECURITY AND ENFORCEMENT

Dear Tenant,

Good day. Over the last few months, we have received a number of complaints from tenants about a few other tenants or their associates attempting to enforce gate security at vehicular gates #1 & #2. Every time this has been reported to us the presumptive “gate guard” has obstructed a legitimate tenant from entering the airport and harassed them. Airport security is the responsibility of Airport Operations, and that authority has not been delegated to any tenants. If you see someone entering the airport that you think does not have access then report the incident to Airport Operations or call the Police (911) if you are witnessing a criminal offense. At no time should any tenants or their associates take it upon themselves to enforce gate security on City property. We have cameras all over the airport and we will investigate the incident.

Tenants who attempt to exercise authority not delegated to them may be subject to lease termination.
